



#### Dandelion Readers - Extended Phonic Code



The English Alphabetic Code is complex and when teaching anything complex, it is necessary to progress from simple to complex in small steps, ensuring practice along the way. For this reason, many programs divide the alphabetic code into the 'Initial Code' and 'Extended' or 'Advanced Code'. The 'Initial Code' includes the letter/sounds of the alphabet, adjacent consonants and consonant digraphs.

The 'Extended Code' is more complex and includes vowel teams (vowel spellings). This is because there are two important underlying aspects of the English Alphabetic Code that children need to learn:

- 1. **Sounds** (phonemes) can be spelled in different ways
- 2. Spellings (graphemes) can represent different sounds

Our Dandelion Readers, Vowel Spellings series introduces vowel spellings in a gradual way.

Level 1 introduces one spelling for a sound, e.g. the spelling <ai> for the sound /ae/

Level 2 introduces 2/3 spellings for a sound, e.g. the spellings <ai>, <ay> and <a> for the

#### sound /ae/

Level 3 introduces 4/5 spellings for vowel sounds adding more alternative spellings to those introduced in Level 2. In addition, a number of books in Level 3 introduce the concept that a grapheme can represent an alternative sound, e.g. in book 6, the spelling <ow> is featured



and the text includes words with the sound /oe/ as in 'grow' and /ow/ as in 'how'.

Our Dandelion Readers Vowel Spellings series allows the teacher to match the text to the number of spelling alternatives they are teaching.

The VCe Spellings set of books is aimed at children learning the VCe spellings who need to practice reading those words in text. This set of books can be introduced before Level 3, which also includes the VCe spellings, as one of a number of spelling alternatives.



## Introduction to the Dragon Eggs Series

Build reading fluency, develop comprehension, and increase confidence

Fluency is one of the critical foundations of reading and it is widely recognized that comprehension is directly linked to reading fluency. To develop fluency children must develop accuracy, pace and prosody (expression).

To achieve reading accuracy children must be taught how to decode words efficiently and at speed. If the reader is focused on decoding words, he/she cannot attend to the meaning of the text.

One of the most difficult aspects of learning to decode the English script is that phonemes can be spelled in different ways. The Dragon Eggs Series has been designed to help children consolidate these alternative spellings. Each book in the series introduces a number of alternative spellings for a vowel sound. The aim of this series is to expose the reader to multiple opportunities to encounter words with these alternative spellings. Repeated practice helps to commit words to long-term memory and in turn develops reading accuracy and speed that will enable reading fluency and comprehension.

A workbook complements the series with activities focused on exposure to alternative spellings. Some activities precede and prepare the student for reading and others follow reading and focus on fluency and comprehension.

#### How to make the most of our books and resources Daily Opportunities to Practice Phonics

Providing daily opportunities to practice phonics is crucial for both early, beginner and later, catch-up readers. Our activity workbooks are integral to the reading scheme as they include teaching and practice activities to support the learner.





To become a reader, a learner needs to acquire the skills of pushing together individual sounds to make a word, this process is called 'blending'. Sounding out the graphemes (spellings) and blending sounds into words is called 'decoding'.

#### Segmenting

To spell words accurately, a learner needs to be able to break a word up into its component sounds. This process is called 'segmenting'. The learner can then represent each sound (phoneme) with the letters that spell the sound.



The learner can then write the letters that represent the sounds in the word and this is called encoding. This is the reverse activity of decoding and should be taught hand in hand.

#### Activities and Games

Easy-to use activities provide a simple, yet effective way to help children develop essential skills for both reading and spelling. These foundational skills build as they progress through the reading series and their corresponding workbooks and start down the path of reading fluency.


