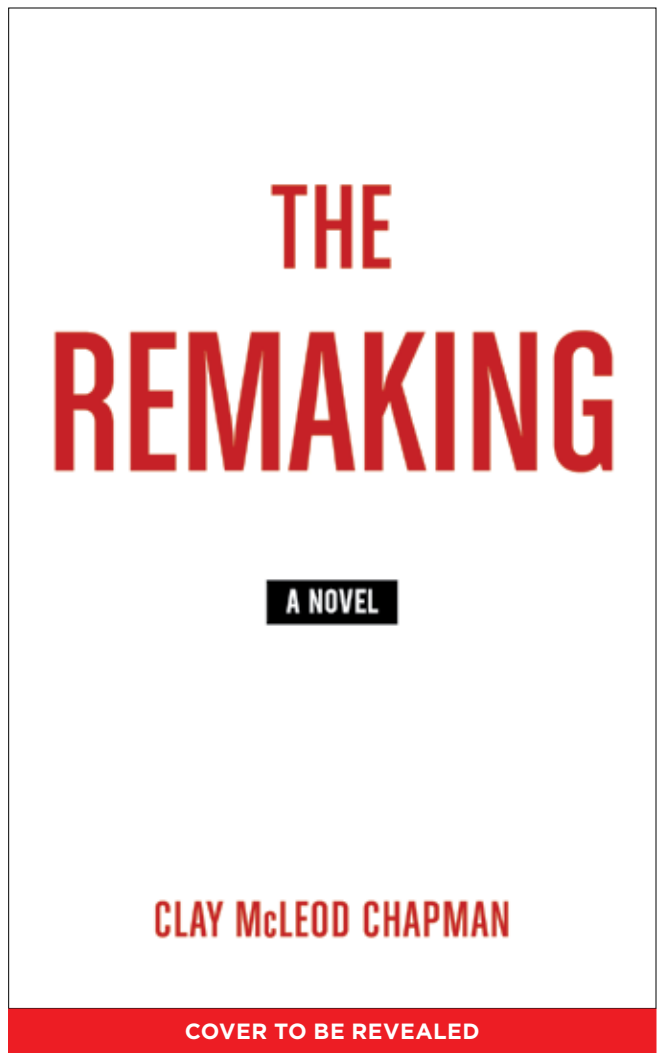
When Ella moves to Pilot's Knob, Virginia, with her young daughter Jessica to start an apothecary, rumors swirl that her shop is a front for witchcraft. That doesn't stop townswomen from visiting the beautiful and mysterious herbalist when traditional medicine fails them. But when a prominent woman miscarries after taking one of Ella's home-made brews, the town accuses Ella and Jessica of witchcraft and burns them at the stake. Ella is hastily buried in the woods, her grave never to be found, but Jessica is buried in a steel-reinforced coffin, surrounded by a fence of interconnected crosses.

It's this extreme act of precaution that keeps their story alive. Sightings of Jessica's ghost wandering around her grave, looking for her mother, add to the legend as it's told—and retold—around summer campfires for decades. But the horrible truth won't be revealed until Amber Lynn—a dead ringer for Jessica—is cast in the '70s horror adaptation inspired by *The Witch Girl of Pilot's Knob*. Amber Lynn claims to meet the real Ella, a troubling assertion that will spark rumors of her insanity and slowly destroy her career. When she returns for the remake in the '90s, the disappearance of a little girl turns into a witch-hunt, with all eyes on Amber Lynn. Her one hope for redemption will come decades later as a true-crime investigator looks into the '90s disappearance and the original legend. But will this final mode of storytelling redeem Amber Lynn or bring an unfathomable horror to the surface?

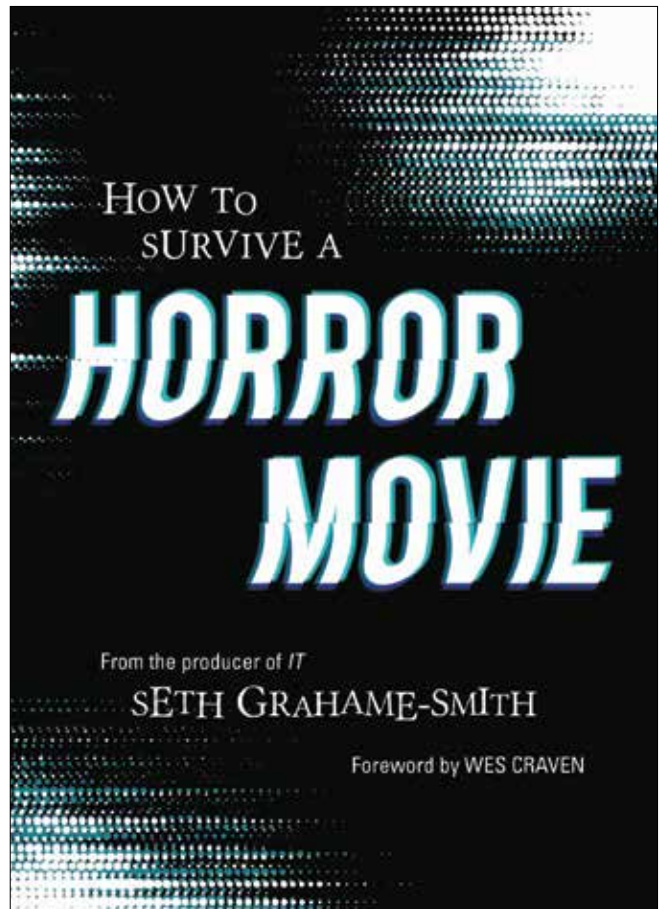

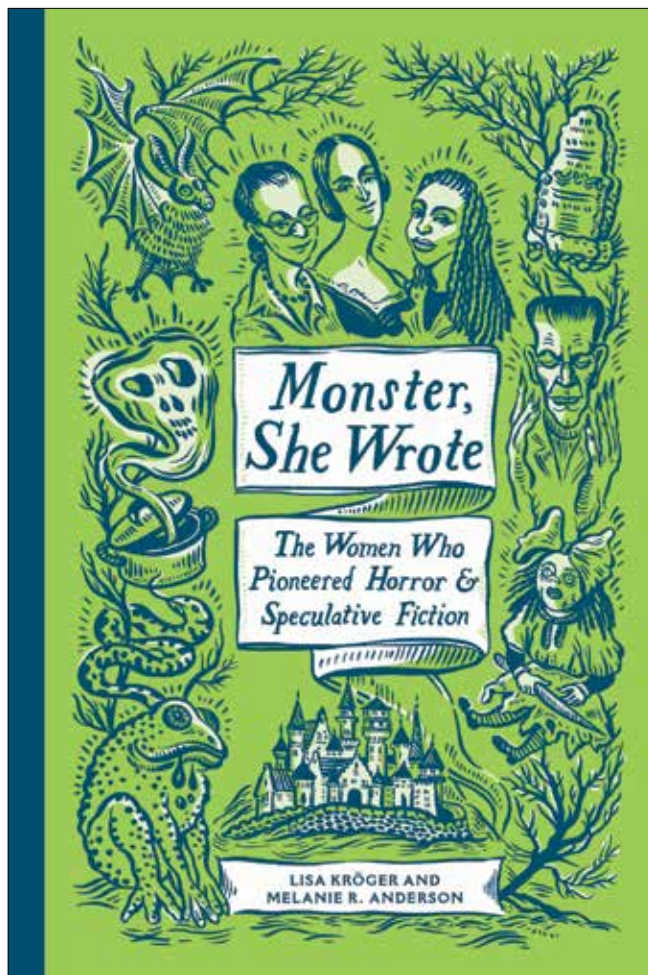

CHAPTER TWO

Haunting Tales

The Victorian Ghost Story



lightening sparked and chandelier roared, Lord Byron suggested a little contest: Who could write the scariest story? It was amid this moody atmosphere charged with sexual tension that *Frankenstein* was born...

"Beware, for I am fearless and therefore powerful."

—Frankenstein Or, The Modern Prometheus

Mary Shelley's own life story began long before that stormy vacation. She was born in 1797 to the well-known philosopher William Godwin and Mary Wollstonecraft, an accomplished writer. Considered by some to be "Britain's first feminist," Wollstonecraft authored *A Vindication for the Rights of Woman* (1792) and was among the first to fight publicly for that cause. She argued that both girls and boys should receive an education and that parental responsibilities should be equally shared.

Wollstonecraft died eleven days after Mary's birth, so the young girl came to know her mother through the latter's writings. Mary's other primary source of information was her father's biography of Wollstonecraft, which brought shade to the family because it revealed the Godwins' relaxed attitude toward monogamy.

As proof of the scandal, Mary Godwin was raised in a blended family with an older half-sister, Fanny Imlay, who was the daughter of Wollstonecraft and her lover Gilbert Imlay. In 1801 Mary's father married

his lover Mary Jane Clairmont, with whom he'd had a daughter, Claire, born only a few months apart. Mary and Claire grew up together and were close friends. The relationship between Mary and her stepmother, however, remained contentious throughout their lives.

As you might expect, Mary received more education than most women of her day. She seemed to share her mother's intellectual process, as well as her penchant for breaking with social norms—particularly when it came to Shelley. Early on, the two arranged for clandestine liaisons at Mary's mother's grave; it's said that she lost her virginity during one such encounter. After declaring their mutual love and eloping, Mary and Percy lived together for more than two years before marrying.

The death of Clara in 1815 shattered the young mother, and it was one of Mary's primary inspirations for *Frankenstein*. She wrote in her journal about *haunting dreams* in which she was able to bring her infant back to life by rubbing her beside a fire. The nightmares continued even after the birth of William the following year, as well as during her travels through Switzerland that summer. In the preface to the 1831 edition of *Frankenstein*, Mary recounts a nightmare she had while at Villa Diodati in which she saw a "hideous" man waking to a new life: her first imaginings of her famous monster.

There was more behind *Frankenstein's* provenance than had dreams and family tragedy. While the rain pelted the villa, the friends inside kept themselves busy by reading. Mary was particularly inspired by Etienne-Gaspard Robert's *Justinaugurie*, a French book about German ghost stories. She was like-
