





Jodi Ecker Detjen and Kelly Watson are the founders and managing partners of Orange Grove Consulting, which helps organizations improve gender equity and inclusivity through consulting tools and training programs.

What would you say is the biggest challenge facing modern workplaces?

The workplace is rapidly diversifying, yet leaders struggle with how to include people who are different. We don't recognize when diversity is missing, we don't measure it, and we don't train it. So while the bottom of the pipeline may finally be attracting fair representations of diverse workers, strongly embedded counterforces ensure we will still have homogeneity at the top for the foreseeable future.

In our time of #MeToo, are you seeing positive changes in gender inequity?


Yes: A veneer has been cracked. What #MeToo did was show women that they were not alone—that their harassment and bias experiences were not unique, and thus not their fault. It seems strange, but this was eye opening for women because the basic underlying assumption was shown to be flawed.

In top-down management structures, how do organizations REFRAME?

Well, it always has to start with the top. But a flawed assumption most organizations have is that they operate a meritocracy. So, this needs to be REFRAMED. We don't have a meritocracy, or else there would be equal representation. Too many times people assume that those in top positions will "naturally know" how to "do" inclusion. How would they know that? By looking at it as a skill, rather than judging, it then can be taught and learned.

What inspired you to found Orange Grove Consulting?

We realized the traditional approach to gender equity failed to recognize the business opportunity gender equity provides for organizations. And let's face it, money talks. Because of our 50+ years of combined operational consulting experience plus our data-based academic research, we felt we could approach the problem from the business perspective and deliver tangible ROI.
