



Ingredients

Cupcakes

- 2 cups all-purpose flour
- 2 teaspoons baking powder
- 1/2 teaspoon salt
- 10 tablespoons unsalted butter, softened
- I cup plus I tbsp sugar
- 2 large eggs
- 2 teaspoons vanilla extract
- ¾ cup milk

Frosting

- 10 tablespoons unsalted butter, softened
- 2 ½ cups confectioners' sugar
- 2 tablespoons milk
- I teaspoon vanilla extract
- food colors

Directions

Step I

Heat oven to 350 degrees. Line 18 muffin cups with baking liners. In a large bowl, combine flour, baking powder, and salt. In another large bowl, use an electric mixer on high speed to beat butter and sugar until light and fluffy, about 4 minutes. Add eggs and vanilla, beating to combine. Reduce mixer speed to low, and alternately add flour mixture and milk.

Step 2

Pour batter into lined cups. Bake at 350 degrees for 25 minutes or until toothpick inserted in center comes out clean.

Step 3

Meanwhile, make vanilla frosting. In a large bowl, with electric mixer on high, beat butter until fluffy, about 4 minutes. Gradually add confectioners' sugar until combined. Add milk and beat until fluffy. Beat in vanilla; tint desired color(s). Frost cooled cupcakes as desired.










Can you set up a picnic photo booth for Very Hungry Caterpillar Day?
