This visit to Britta Teckentrup's Fluffyville community takes young readers through the day in the life of an active farm. From the early morning barn chores, working in the garden, and a hearty midday lunch to an afternoon in the pool and a late-night party, each of the seven beautifully illustrated double-page spreads is overflowing with activity, familiar characters, and interesting aspects of farm life. Simple texts encourage young readers to explore each spread, looking for recurring themes and discovering hidden clues. Cows go to pasture, apples are harvested from the tree, pigs are fed, and there's even a late-night visit from the vet. Fans of Teckentrup's other Fluffyville volume will also delight in the return of a certain mischievous badger. ## WHEN I FEEL LONELY

BRITTA TECKENTRUP

With luminous, evocative illustrations and rhymed texts, this book gently explores the feeling of loneliness through the perspective of a young girl. It acknowledges that, while feeling alone is natural and something everyone experiences, it also conveys how unsettling and scary the sensation can be. In her characteristically sensitive style, Teckentrup explores the quiet moments when the world seems distant and we are left grappling with the heavy silence that surrounds us. The narrative doesn't shy away from the intensity of these emotions, instead offering an honest portrayal of how loneliness can feel like an all-encompassing shadow. In a world where many children, and adults, are grappling with such intense emotions, *When I Feel Lonely* provides a calm, compassionate and understanding voice, helping young readers to recognize and name their feelings. The book reassures children that while loneliness can be sad and difficult, it is a part of life that everyone experiences. And best of all it offers a glimmer of hope, showing that even in the darkest moments, there is the possibility of light and connection ahead.

**BRITTA TECKENTRUP** is a German-born author and illustrator who has gained international recognition for her work in children's literature. With a career spanning over two decades, she has authored and illustrated more than one hundred books, which have been translated into multiple languages. Previous titles include *When I See Red*, *When I Feel Brave*, *The Swing*, the *Fluffyville* series and the *Big Hedgehog* and *Little Hedgehog* series, all published by Prestel.

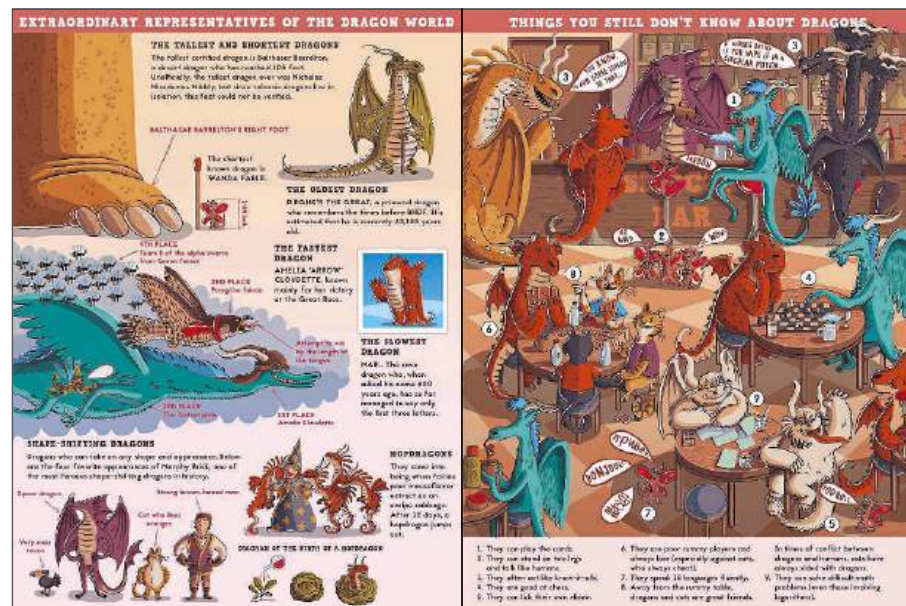

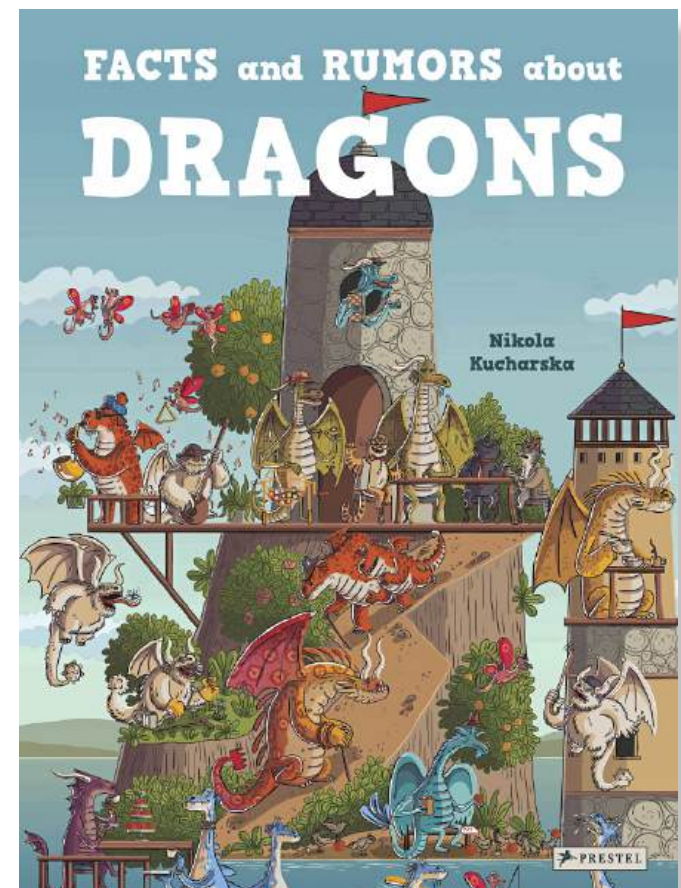

Fact: Dragons are fluent in eighteen languages. Fact: Dragons don’t actually breathe fire—they just have really bad indigestion. Fact: This book is perfect for kids that love dragons, facts, and a good laugh.

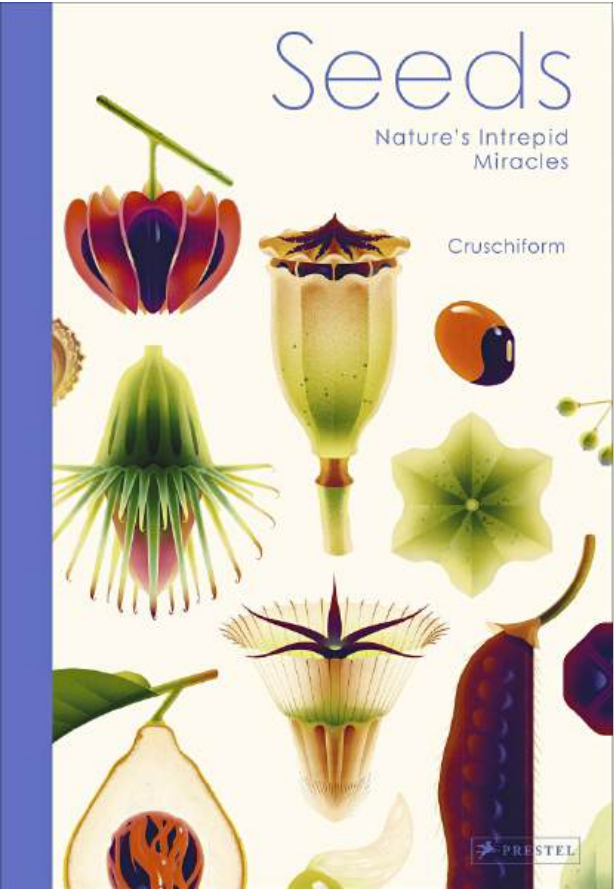

Each page features a single seed, brought to life through exquisite illustrations that capture its intricate details and unique characteristics. Organized by the ways in which seeds are dispersed—by wind, water, or human and animal interaction—the book features brief, engaging texts that explain how nature has perfectly designed each seed for its specific role. Readers will encounter the brilliant green spiral of the alfalfa seed, which scatters far and wide when grown in the wild. They will find new fascination in familiar seeds like the sugar maple's jewel-like propellers and the wild carrot's dome of tiny white flowers. They'll discover how one of the largest seeds—the coconut—has a hollow, waterproof shell that enables it to journey across oceans. And they'll marvel at the fearsome horns of the water chestnut, which anchors itself in the mud to germinate. This celebration of life and growth is perfect for young readers curious about the natural world, combining scientific accuracy with artistic beauty to create a reading experience that will encourage further learning as well as an interest in protecting our fragile, miraculous planet.

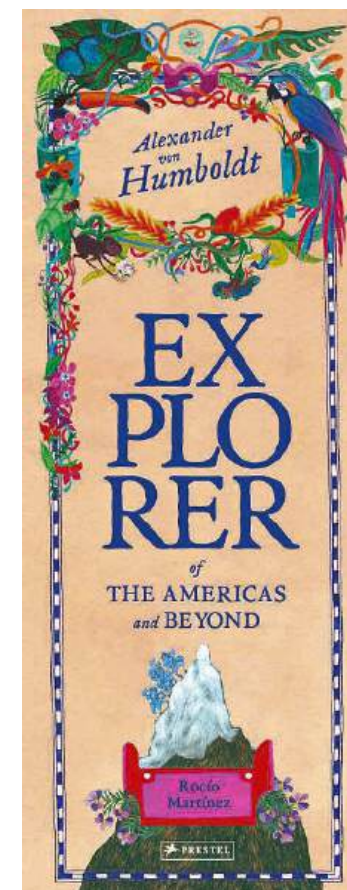

Readers will learn about the Humboldt Current, his observations of volcanoes and mines, his thwarted ascent of Mount Chimborazo, the discovery of the Casiquiare canal, his invention of isotherms, and much more. Each page is a treasure trove of information and a stepping off point for conversation and further study. Best of all, Humboldt's life and achievements provide timely inspiration for budding environmentalists and explorers who want to learn about the remarkable interconnectedness between humans and the natural world.

## METAPHORS

### UNDERSTANDING PHILOSOPHY THROUGH IMAGES

PEDRO ALCALDE AND MERLÍN ALCALDE, ILLUSTRATIONS BY GUIM TÍO

The word metaphor comes to us from Ancient Greek, in which it meant “transfer.” In this book, philosophical concepts from throughout history and from all over the world, are transferred into images, which help us to understand the world that surrounds us using memorable colors and shapes. Designed for those curious about philosophy and its intricacies, this elegant and accessible book explores twenty-four metaphors, that are foundational to our understanding of the human experience and the mysteries of existence. Each double-page spread explores a specific metaphor such as the mirror, light, an iceberg, or the matrix. One side of the spread offers information about the philosopher; an original quote; the source text; a symbol for each metaphor; and contextual background. The opposite page features a gorgeous artwork that encapsulates the overarching significance of the metaphor it illustrates. From Heraclitus’ “river,” the first metaphor of western philosophy, to the “liquid metaphor” a concept introduced by the sociologist Zygmunt Bauman to describe the characteristics of contemporary society, this fascinating guide is a clear and memorable introduction to world philosophy. It’s the perfect book for a budding philosopher or anyone interested in in exploring profound ideas through art.

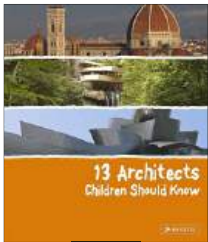
